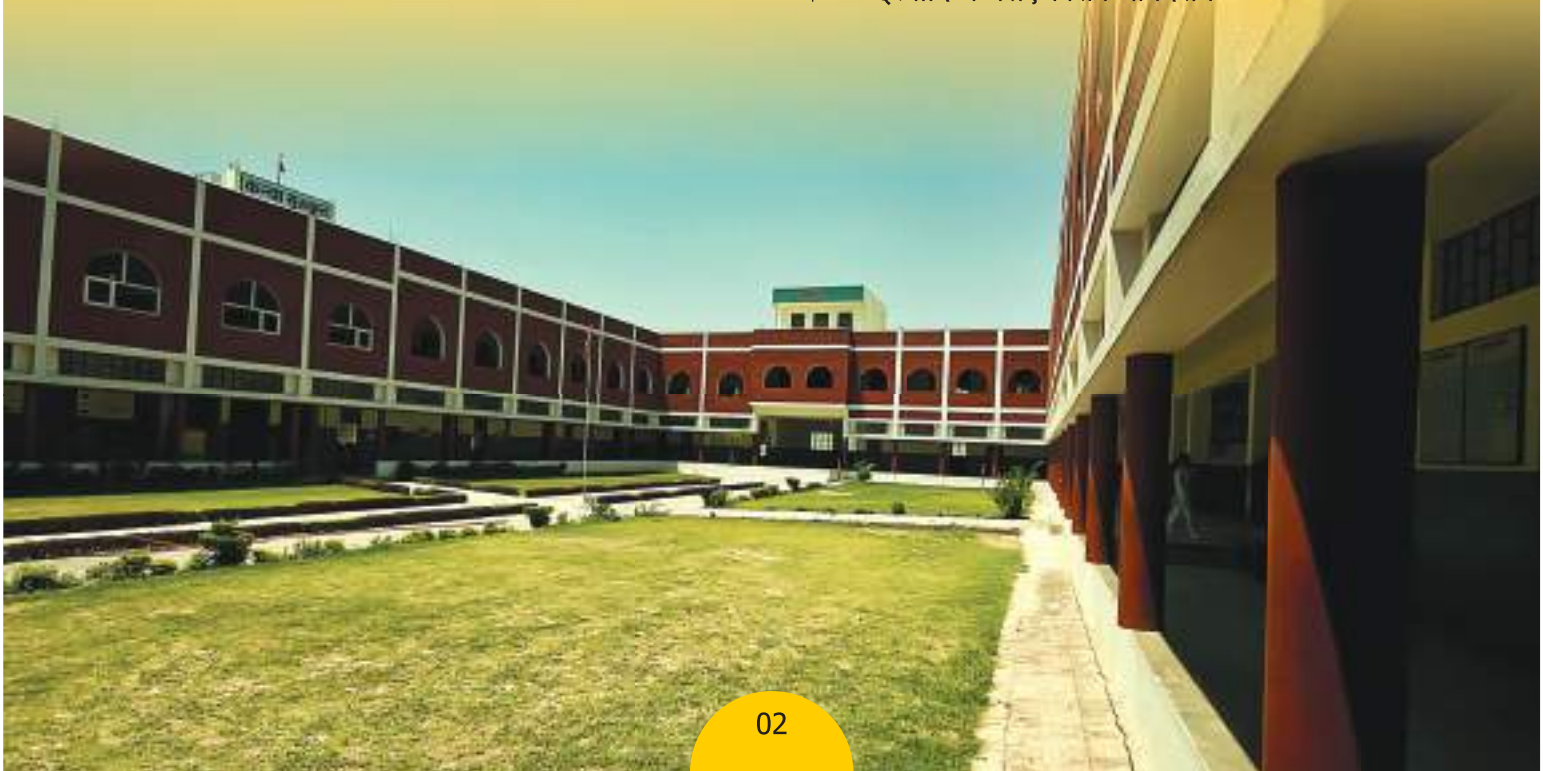

Introduction

The word **Amatir** comes from Sanskrit language meaning 'Knowledge'.

AMATIR KANYA GURUKUL Kurukshetra enlightens the lives of girls by providing them modern education with ancient 'Sanskaras', giving due importance to Indian ancient value system for proper development of their personalities, character and health; encouraging them to adopt simple living and high thinking; promoting positive attitude and creating awareness about their culture and society.

Amatir is run under the aegis of Anant Charitable Trust. The Board of Trustees include distinguished educationists, lawyers and eminent citizens. The School that was started with 27 girl students in April 2002, has now become a prestigious institution and is progressing by leaps and bounds.

LOCATION

Amatir is set in the lap of nature, away from the noise and pollution of the city providing a very calm and peaceful atmosphere with lush green lawns and a variety of trees and flowers where the minds and souls of the children have freedom to think and act on their own. It is situated about 9 kilometers from Kurukshetra (Haryana) on Lukhi Road.

ACADEMICS & AFFILIATION

Amatir is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) – Affiliation No. 530865, School Code 40834). The medium of teaching is English for all classes. It offers Medical, Non-Medical, Commerce & Arts streams for 10+1 & 10+2 classes with Math, Economics, Political Science, Psychology, History, Computer Science, Home Science, Physical Education,

Fine Arts, Hindi and Food Production as optional subjects. Amatir believes in student centric teaching-learning methodology for which its teachers are equipped with the most interactive, engaging, experiential learning tools that results into progression in thinking and learning outcomes. It aims to nurture the inherent potential of every child leading to a stage-wise learning evolution.

FACULTY

A Teacher is one who not only imparts knowledge but also teaches us the various aspects of life. The Teacher is a second parent to a child. Amatir has a highly educated and experienced faculty that takes care of students in the School as well as in the Hostel.

In addition to teaching in the school, the resident teachers are inducted into various profiles in the hostel like The House Masters, Tutor, Hostel Supervisor, Hostel Coordinator, Activity incharge and Academic Coordinator. Students in the hostel have been divided class wise into five wings. Two teachers, assigned as House Masters to each wing, take care of physical, mental, emotional and moral well-being of the students.

TECHNOLOGY IN THE CLASSROOMS

All classrooms at Amatir are equipped with digital equipments, thereby enable teachers to play digital content and provide access to unlimited world wide web resources. Audio-Visual aids make teaching & learning process more effective by making subject more interactive & interesting, thus attracting and retaining learners' attention.



COMPUTER LAB

Amatir has a well-equipped computer lab with a projector. A Broadband internet connection enables the students in their research work. Computer education is introduced to students from grade 3rd onwards as part of the curriculum as well as a tool to perform activity oriented tasks. Students use technology to collaborate with other school students from various countries.

MATHEMATICS LAB

Mathematics lab at Amatir helps take fear of Math subject out of the minds of students by making concepts fun to learn and easy to understand with the help of Maths kits. Highly recognized "Jodo Gyan" kits are used for the primary classes.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LAB

Amatir understands the importance of English language in today's global environment and lays special emphasis on listening, speaking, writing and reading skills for our girl students. Our language lab is equipped with the latest software for learning English language and is proving to be game changer especially for those girls who have very weak foundation in the English language.

HOME SCIENCE AND FOOD PRODUCTION LAB

Cooking is an art and one of the most crucial skill for any girl student to have. Amatir has a state of art Food Production Lab where girls learn to cook healthy and delicious dishes under the supervision of the home science teacher. The intention while cooking is the most critical attribute during this process. They are counseled to achieve mind-body balance, mentored to realize the importance of cooking and serving the meals with a smile.



SCIENCE LABORATORIES

The institution has well equipped science labs with modern apparatus and appliances for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. The



various mysteries of science are unraveled in these laboratories through experiments and practical experiences.

VEDIC EDUCATION

Vedic education is not an abstract term for the Amatir students but it is manifested in the individual, philosophical, cultural, social and spiritual aspects of their lives. 'Hawan' in the morning and 'Sandhya' in the evening are inseparable part of students' life. A learned Acharya Ji, like an affectionate father and effective teacher, inculcates the value education and Vedic preaching among the students. The Vedic education is planned in a manner that it is appropriate to students' mental developmental abilities and supports their physical, intellectual and emotional development.





LIBRARY

Amatir has a well-stocked spacious library where 50 students can sit and study simultaneously. There are more than 5000 books in our library in both the genre - Fiction like historical fiction, science fiction, realistic fiction and Non-fiction like biographies, poems & drama, informational and traditional literature.

COUNSELLING

We have a renowned professional school counsellor on our panel. In addition to that our teachers are also trained in counselling techniques. Counselor coordinator counsels the new students for their smooth settling down in the hostel. She also addresses any emotional/psychological issue that girls might be going through.

MEDICAL FACILITY

Anant Charitable Trust runs a dispensary in the School premises. All the medicines in the dispensary are provided free of cost. There is a full time staff nurse who resides in the hostel. Doctor is always available on call during any emergency. Periodic medical checkups for students as well as the staff are arranged. There is eight-bed recovery room in the hostel. We also have top hospitals of the city on our panel to take care of serious illnesses or emergencies.



SPORTS

Amatir has two playgrounds of 6 acres and 2 acres each where in students play sports during the school hours and get coaching in Athletics, Handball, Volleyball, Football, Judo, Martial Arts in the evening by highly qualified sports instructors. Haryana Sports Dept. has allocated three sports nurseries in the school namely: Athletics, Handball and Boxing. Our students have represented our school at state and national level in these sports. Girls also play games like Table Tennis, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Badminton and various indoor games like chess, carom board and computer games.

Sports students are provided extra diet to meet their additional calories requirement.



HOSTEL FACILITY

Amatir provides very secure, homely, comfortable surroundings for the 300 girls in the hostel where they feel happy, safe and content. Extra Coaching is imparted to resident students in both scholastic and co-scholastic subjects.



Amatir Kanya Gurukul has its own Solar power generation plant which provides 24x7 supply of electricity to the entire campus. Hot and Cold potable water is supplied through out the year. Girls are provided with nutritious and delicious pure vegetarian diet, which includes meals with legumes, vegetables, rice & roti, fortified with fruits and Milk. At present, there are students from Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal.

CANTEEN

There are two Canteen counters, one at school and another at the hostel, where students can buy stationary, daily use items, uniform, eatables, etc. at very reasonable price. The Canteen committee decides what items are to be made available at the canteen.

CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES IN THE SCHOOL

Dance – Contemporary and Classical dance forms are taught. Our students have participated in inter school as well as state level competitions.

Theater – Our students are trained by an artist from "Ashmita Theater Group" for stage-plays and "Nukkad Nataks". The students are trained to write their own scripts which gives them the confidence to speak with conviction. These plays are performed in various villages and schools conveying message on various social issues. Inquilab, our theatre group, achieved the feat of performing 100th street play on 7th Jan 2018.

Art – Qualified teachers hone the drawing skills of the students in various forms of the paintings. Children's creations, reflecting vastness of their creativity, leave us speechless. The strokes and the color combinations are inspiring and compel us to think.

Paper Recycling – Girls at Amatar practice recycling in its true spirit by processing lots of old paper in our self-developed paper recycling unit. Recycled New paper is used to prepare various types of items like – Diary, chart paper, wrapping paper, envelopes etc.

Quilling – Amatar students have mastered the art of making jewelry using thick paper sheets. Their creations are always admired by all the guests, students and teachers. Very soon students will start marketing their products which will develop entrepreneur skills in them and act as a great motivator.



Vocal Music – "Music helps to express one's feelings" Our music teacher is a researcher, scholar and accomplished performer herself and extremely passionate about music subject. Our students learn classical vocal music and participate in various concerts & programs for showcasing their talent.

Instrumental Music – Playing an instrument not only develops amazing mathematical and alertness skill but also helps the students to improve their hand-eye coordination and memorizing skills. Instruments like Violin, Tabla, Synthesizer and Sitar are taught to our students.





Cooking – Amatir girls learn to cook variety of cuisines and condiments like Pickles, Jam and Sauce. They also learn to pack their products and use preservatives for its longer shelf life. Food carnival organized by our girls is one of the most sought after event for the nearby community and students alike.

Evaluation and Assessment

The evaluation system is continuous and comprehensive. The academic year is divided into two terms :

• **First Term : April to September**

• **Second Term : October to March**

Class tests are held at regular intervals. Weightage is allotted for the tests, project work, assignments, practical's etc.

Parent Teacher Meetings

A child's education is the combined responsibility of the school and the parents. To facilitate continuous interaction between the parents and the teachers, special days have been earmarked for Parent Teacher Meetings. Besides, parents can meet the principal for any necessity between 10:00am to 1:00pm on first & last Saturday. Parents are not allowed to meet a teacher or their ward during working hours without the permission of the Principal.

Scholastic

The academic curriculum for the different classes are as follows:

Class I to V - Three languages, Numeracy, EVS/Science


Class VI to VIII - Three languages, Numeracy, Science, Social Science

Class IX to X - Three languages, Numeracy, Science, Social science, IT

Class XI to XII - One language, Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Biology, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Psychology, Political Science, History, Music–Vocal, Music–Instrumental, Physical education, Home Science, Food Production and Fine Arts.

Co-Scholastic

Arts, dance, music, craft, any one of the sports (Athletics, Handball, Volleyball, Football, Basketball, Taekwondo, any one of the Clubs (Paper making, Quilling, Cooking, Theater, Photography).

House System

The house system in our school has a special significance. With the objective of developing a sense of healthy competition and camaraderie, all the students are assigned to one of the four houses, namely – Ganga (Green), Yamuna (Yellow), Rewa (Red), Kaveri (Blue)

The name of the houses depicts rivers not just in letter but in spirit as these rivers are abundant source of energy, which when tapped can be used in constructive activities like irrigation, electricity generation, drinking etc. but if untapped can lead to destruction and disaster. Similarly, we see our girls as a representation of these pious and flowing rivers wherein Amrit and parents are two banks of these rivers. It's our collective responsibility to channelize their energy into learning various life skills like communication, citizenship, digitalization, leadership, critical thinking, problem solving thus leading them to become a confident, disciplined, empathetic, cultured, decisive, leader and an aware citizen.

Each house has a Teacher-in-charge, a house captain and a vice-captain. Inter-house competitions are held for all co-scholastic activities. The house that scores the maximum points at the end of the year is declared as the 'Champion House'.

Each house is put 'On-Duty' turn by turn and organizes activities like conducting morning assembly, attending to the cleanliness of the school, checking of late comers, reading the news of the day, maintaining display boards and ensuring overall discipline.



वैदिक शिक्षा का महत्व

“ईश्वर से लेकर पृथ्वी प्रयन्त पदार्थों का सत्य विज्ञान होकर उनसे यथायोग्य उपकार लेने का नाम ही विद्या है”

- स्वामी दयानंद सरस्वती जी महाराज

यजुर्वेद के १०वें अध्याय में कहा है कि 'विद्या अमृतमश्नुते' अर्थात् विद्या से परम सुख की प्राप्ति होती है। विद्या शब्द के धात्वर्थ से भी देखा जाए तो यही सिद्ध होता है कि (वेति यया सा विद्या) जिससे पदार्थ का यथार्थ ज्ञान हो, वही विद्या है।

वैशेषिक दर्शन में इसी बात को कुछ भिन्न प्रकार से कहा गया है - तद्दुष्टमअज्ञान्म अदुष्टम विद्या ॥ अध्याय ९/१
अविद्या को ही दुष्ट ज्ञान कहते हैं और दुष्ट ज्ञान से भिन्न यथार्थ परम ज्ञान को विद्या कहते हैं।

वैदिक साहित्य विद्या का अक्षय भंडार है। विद्या से प्राप्त होने वाले लाभों का उल्लेख इस प्रकार से है - 'सा विद्या या विमुक्तये' अर्थात् विद्या वह (वस्तु) है जिसमें परमसुख मोक्ष की प्राप्ति होती है।

केनोपनिषद में लिखा है - 'विद्या विन्दते अमृतम्' अर्थात् विद्या से ही परम आनंद की प्राप्ति होती है।

विद्या से प्राप्त होने वाले लाभों को भोज प्रबंध में इस प्रकार निरूपित किया गया है - माता जिस प्रकार से संतान का पालन पोषण व रक्षण करती है, ऐसे ही विद्या भी मनुष्य का पालन पोषण व रक्षण करती है। यद्यपि माता केवल बाल्यवस्था में ही संतान का रक्षण करती है, परंतु विद्या सब अवस्थाओं में मनुष्य का पालनादि करती है और जैसे पिता, संतान का जिसमें हित हो उसमें संतान को लगाता है, ऐसे ही विद्या भी मनुष्य को हिताहित का ज्ञान कराकर, हित में प्रवृत्त कराती है। विद्या ही एक ऐसी वस्तु है जो मनुष्य की संसार भर में महकीर्ति को विस्तृत कराकर, यथेष्ट धन की प्राप्ति करा देती है।

भोजप्रबंधकार कहता है की संसार में ऐसा कौन सा पदार्थ है जो विद्यारूप कल्पलता से न प्राप्त हो सके। अतः हमें चाहिए की हम ऐसी विद्या में सदैव तत्पर रहें जो हमें व्यवहारिक ज्ञान के साथ-साथ शारीरिक, मानसिक एवं बौद्धिक विकास में योगदान दे सके।

विद्यालय के नियम

1. अभिभावकों को केवल पहचान पत्र द्वारा ही स्कूल में प्रवेश एवं छात्र/छात्रा से मिलने की अनुमति दी जाएगी। कृपया दाखिले के तुरंत बाद ही पहचान पत्र बनवा लें।
2. गुरुकुल में किसी भी छात्रा को अपने पास धनराशि, मोबाइल फोन या कोई अन्य इलेक्ट्रॉनिक डिवाइस, गहने या कोई अन्य मूल्यवान वस्तु लाने व रखने की अनुमति नहीं है। इस नियम की अवहेलना करने की स्थिति में निषेध वस्तु जब्त कर ली जाएगी और छात्रा के खिलाफ सख्त कार्यवाही की जाएगी, जिसमें आर्थिक दंड व निष्काशन भी शामिल है।
3. कोई भी छात्र या छात्रा, प्राचार्या द्वारा लिखित अनुमति के बिना गुरुकुल से अनुपस्थित ना रहे। ऐसा करने से छात्र/छात्रा की पढ़ाई का नुकसान होगा और अभिभावक को **100 रुपए प्रतिदिन** उपेक्षा शुल्क देना होगा।
4. परीक्षाओं के समय में किसी भी छात्रा को कोई अवकाश नहीं मिलेगा। परीक्षा से अनुपस्थित होने की स्थिति में परीक्षा पुनः नहीं ली जाएगी।
5. छात्रा प्रति दिन स्कूल डायरी में हर विषय का मिला हुआ गृहकार्य लिखेगी जिसपर प्रतिदिन अभिभावक या सहायक हाउस मास्टर के हस्ताक्षर होना अनिवार्य है। अभिभावक भी इस बात का ध्यान करें कि बच्चा गृहकार्य नियमित रूप से करे।
6. विद्यालय व बोर्ड की परीक्षा का पात्र होने के लिए सभी छात्राओं के लिए प्रत्येक विषय में **75%** उपस्थिति होना अनिवार्य है।
7. यदि कोई छात्रा अनुशासनहीनता, दुर्यवहार, चोरी, गुरुकुल सम्पत्ति को नुकसान पहुँचाना, बिना अनुमति के चले जाना, परीक्षा में नकल करने आदि की दोषी पायी जाती है तो उस छात्रा के खिलाफ सख्त कार्यवाही की जाएगी, जिसमें आर्थिक दंड व निष्काशन भी शामिल है।
8. बच्चों के सर्वांगीण विकास के लिए अभिभावकों एवं अध्यापकों में सहयोग आवश्यक है। अभिभावक बच्चों की डायरी अवश्य देखें तथा उन्हें विकासोन्मुख बनाए रखने के लिए प्रोत्साहित व पथ प्रदर्शन करते रहें।
9. ग्रीष्मावकाश से पहले व निर्धारित PTM के दिन कक्षाचार्या से अवश्य मिलें और यूनिट टेस्ट के नतीजों, रिपोर्ट कार्ड व छात्रा के निरंतर विकास की जानकारी अवश्य लें।
10. स्कूल डायरी या पहचान पत्र खो जाने की स्थिति में पुनः बनवाने के लिए **100 रुपए** का शुल्क लगेगा।
11. छात्राओं को गुरुकुल में नकद राशि रखने की अनुमति नहीं है। सभी छात्राओं के स्कूल कैंटीन खर्चों के लिए एक अलग अकाउंट बना होता है जिसमें अभिभावक जरूरत अनुसार धनराशि जमा करवाएँ। छात्रा कैंटीन से सामान लेने के लिए कैंटीन स्लिप का इस्तेमाल करती है जिसपर अभिभावक या हाउस मास्टर/सहायक हाउस मास्टर/हॉस्टल सुपरवाइजर के हस्ताक्षर होने अनिवार्य हैं। कैंटीन स्लिप के अनुसार छात्रा के कैंटीन अकाउंट से धन निकाल लिया जाता है। अभिभावक अकाउंट ऑफिस से किसी भी समय इस विषय में पड़ताल कर हिसाब देख सकते हैं।
12. सभी छात्रायें व अभिभावक गुरुकुल के अनुशासन को बनाए रखने के लिए अपने को गुरुकुल के समय – समय पर बनने वाले नियमों व नियमावली से अवगत रखें।

छात्रावास के नियम

1. गुरुकुल छात्रावास में रहने वाली छात्राओं के माता पिता/अभिभावक सहित चार व्यक्तियों को केवल पहचान पत्र के साथ ही मिलने की अनुमति होगी।
2. छात्राओं के माता/पिता/अभिभावकों को निर्धारित दिनों पर ही छात्राओं को मिलने की अनुमति होगी।
3. गुरुकुल परिसर में डिस्पेन्सरी में इलाज निशुल्क है पर बाहर किसी अन्य अस्पताल में इलाज के लिए शुल्क अलग से देय होगा।
4. अभिभावक केवल स्वागत कक्ष में ही आ सकते हैं। छात्रावास के अंदर जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी।
5. छात्राओं को कान और नाक में छोटी बाली या स्टड पहनने की ही अनुमति है। इसके अलावा गुरुकुल में कोई भी जेवर पहनना या लाना वर्जित है।
6. छात्रावास में 'सेवा' के माध्यम से छात्राएँ गुरुकुल के कार्यों में योगदान करती हैं। इस प्रक्रिया में भाग लेना सभी के लिए अनिवार्य है।
7. छात्रावास में किसी भी तेजधार वस्तु जैसे कैंची, ब्लेड, चाकू रखना वर्जित है।
8. अभिभावक कृपया अवकाश की तारीख के अनुसार ही अपने बच्चे को लेने के लिए आएँ। समय से पहले ले जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी। बिना अनुमति के अवकाश अवधि से पहले जाने या देर से आने पर अभिभावक को **500 रुपये प्रतिदिन** की दर से उपेक्षा शुल्क देना होगा।
9. हर छात्रा को 14 दिनों में एक पूर्व निर्धारित दिन पर, 10 मिनट के लिए, अभिभावकों से फोन पर बात करने की अनुमति होती है।
10. नई छात्राओं को पहले 14 दिनों तक अभिभावक से बात करने या मिलने की अनुमति नहीं होगी। नई छात्राओं के अभिभावकों को हाउस मिस्ट्रेस द्वारा समय-समय पर छात्रा के हाल और व्यवहार का समाचार दिया जाएगा। यह प्रक्रिया नई छात्राओं को छात्रावास के वातावरण में ढालने के लिए अनिवार्य होती है।
11. गर्मी, दिवाली या सर्दी के अवकाश के अलावा, किसी अन्य कारण से, 4 से ज़्यादा दिन के अवकाश पर जाने की स्थिति में छात्रा को अपना सारा सामान ब्लॉक रूम में जमा करवाना होगा।
12. छात्रा एक सत्र में 7 दिन तक का अवकाश ले सकती है। अवकाश लेने के लिए प्राचार्या जी से पूर्व अनुमति लेना आवश्यक है। इस अवकाश को गर्मी, दिवाली या सर्दी के अवकाश के साथ जोड़ा नहीं जा सकता है।

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR DEPOSIT OF SCHOOL DUES:


1. Fees are charged from the 1st of April whether pupils join on that date or not.
2. All dues are to be deposited quarterly as specified below - For all classes except XI (New Admissions)
 - By April 15th (For the 1st Quarter [April to June]) • By July 15th (For the Second Quarter [July to Sept.])
 - By Oct. 15th (For the Third Quarter [Oct. to Dec]) • By Jan. 15th (For the Fourth Quarter [Jan. to March])
3. Dues for newly admitted students in class XI are to be deposited half-yearly as specified below -
 - By April 15th (For the 1st half year [April to Sept.] • By Oct 15th (For the 2nd half year [Oct to Mar])
4. Late Fine for dues deposited after the abovementioned dates will be charged at the rate given below: -
 - a) Rs. 20/- per day for the first seven days.
 - b) Rs. 50/- per day from the eighth day onwards.
5. If there is any delay in paying the fees, the pupil will be withheld from appearing for the Terminal examinations.
6. All fees of the year must be cleared before the final examination.
7. In case any Fee concession has been granted, then it shall be cancelled if fee dues are not deposited in time as per the applicable schedule.
8. The parents/guardians must retain the receipts issued to them as a proof of payment and produce it, when asked for.

RULES RELATED TO WITHDRAWAL :

1. Fees once paid will not be refunded in case of withdrawal.
2. Two months notice is to be given before the withdrawal of a pupil or school fees will be charged.

DUES PAYMENT IN CASE OF DISCONTINUANCE OF THE USE OF A FACILITY:

- 1) If a boarder wants to be a day scholar in the mid of the session, then she will be required to pay full charges of a regular hosteller for the remaining part of that session.
- 2) If a day boarder is availing transport facility provided by the school then she must pay the bus charges for the complete session even if she stops availing the facility during the mid of session.
- 3) In case of indiscipline in the hostel or in the school vehicle, the student can be expelled from the hostel or disallowed the use of school vehicle. In such cases, however, the student must continue to pay the regular hostel or transport charges for the remaining period of the session.
